July 30 is the WORLD DAY AGAINST TRAFFICKING IN PERSONS, a global campaign observed annually to raise awareness of human trafficking.

According to Equality Now, trafficking can affect <u>anyone</u>, including adults, but 1 in 3 victims is a child, with girls making up the majority of child trafficking cases. Children are also twice as likely to face violence when trafficked than adults.
